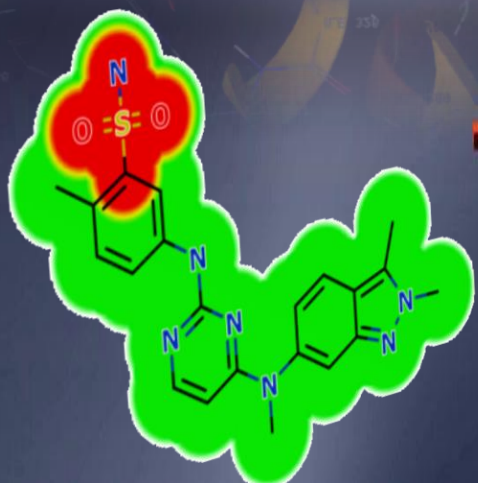
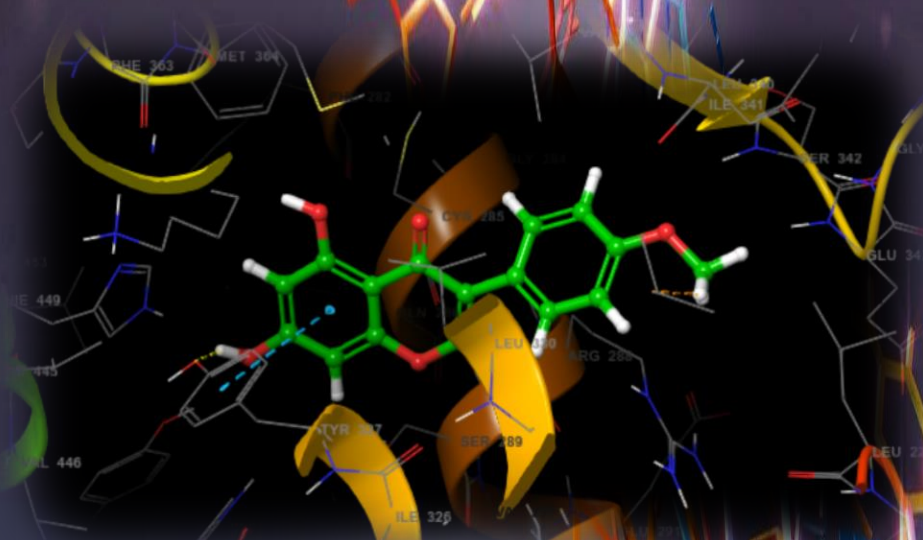

RIPER started in the year 2002 with Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) followed by Diploma of Pharmacy (D. Pharm) and has attained enormous growth by offering Master of Pharmacy (M. Pharm) in various specializations such as Pharmaceutical Analysis, Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology, Pharmacy Practice, Industrial Pharmacy, Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D). It is our pride to inform that we are conducting Pharm. D (Doctor of Pharmacy) Programme (Six years integrated course) and Pharm. D (Post Baccalaureate) by giving exposure to the students at various National Hospitals.

RIPER is one of the largest premier pharmacy institute in the country, approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi and affiliated by Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Anantapur (JNTUA), Andhra Pradesh, India.
