


- NSS Volunteers conducted awareness on importance of Immunization, nutrition in Child health on 09/03/2020.

NSS volunteers were registered in Yoga Certification Board, Ministry of AYUSH, and Government of India and participated in worldwide movement.
























COVID-19 Awareness Quiz


Parakram Divas 2021 Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's birth anniversary


On this day writing, drawing activities were conducted for students.
